

Hasan Maulahela, MD, PhD, FACG, FASGE is an Indonesian consultant gastroenterologist and advanced interventional endoscopist based in Jakarta.

He works at **Dr. Cipto Mangunkusumo National General Hospital (RSCM)** and is affiliated with the **Division of Gastroenterology, Department of Internal Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, Universitas Indonesia**. RSCM lists his clinical field as internal medicine with subspecialty expertise in gastroenterology, pancreatobiliary disease, and gastrointestinal endoscopy.



His principal areas of expertise include:

- Diagnostic and therapeutic gastrointestinal endoscopy
- Endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography (**ERCP**)
- Endoscopic ultrasound (**EUS**)
- Pancreatobiliary disorders
- Gastrointestinal bleeding
- Endoscopy education and competency-based training

Public professional profiles describe him as a consultant and academic physician involved with RSCM's integrated advanced endoscopy service. His postgraduate training includes internal medicine and gastroenterology-hepatology at Universitas Indonesia, followed by advanced endoscopy training or fellowships in centres including the Asian Institute of Gastroenterology in Hyderabad and institutions in South Korea and Japan.

Dr. Maulahela is also active in clinical research and medical education. His publications cover subjects such as simulation-based endoscopy training, endoscopic ultrasound, functional gastrointestinal disorders, *Helicobacter pylori*, and therapeutic endoscopy. Examples include a prospective study comparing simulation-based mastery learning with conventional apprenticeship for basic endoscopy training and a widely cited review on the diagnosis of intestinal tuberculosis.

The postnominals **FACG** and **FASGE** indicate fellowship recognition from the American College of Gastroenterology and the American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy, respectively. Overall, his professional profile combines advanced endoscopic practice, academic teaching, trainee supervision, and gastroenterology research.
